### Application Guidelines

**Submission Deadline:** Thursday, September 15, 2022

**Eligible Organizations:** The Greater Alliance Foundation will only make grants to qualified 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations.

**Size of Grants:** For this grant cycle, GIVE Alliance 365 has \$15,000 available for grants. Grant requests between \$500 and \$5,000 will be accepted.

**Focus Area:** Improving Literacy

**Duration:** GIVE Alliance 365 grants are for a period of up to one year, with the expectation that the full amount of the grant will be used within that time.

**Geographic Range:** GIVE Alliance 365 grants must benefit agencies that serve people in the Alliance area - including Marlinton, Sebring and West Branch.

**Leadership and Fiscal Accountability:** Grantees must have the leadership capacity, financial stability, and appropriate procedures in place for fiscal and organizational accountability.

**Collaboration:**

If you submit an application that is a collaborative effort, one organization must be identified as the grantee.

If you are working with other organizations, foundations or businesses, please identify them and describe the intended working relationship with each in the appropriate section of the application.

**GIVE Alliance 365 invites proposals for:**

- **Program grants** for existing project or program costs.
- **Start-up grants** for emerging programs that show initial success and are sustainable.
- **Capacity-building grants** to increase the range of services or to serve more clients on an ongoing basis.
- **Match grants** to help leverage funding from other sources
